Protect Your Door Act

Defending Your 4th Amendment Rights

Pass HB 4114

Your constitutional rights are only meaningful if enforceable. Working families have seen their 4th Amendment protections violated without accountability. This new law holds individuals personally responsible for infringing on someone's right to privacy and security in their home.

The Protect Your Door Act strengthens your Fourth Amendment right to be secure in your own home. If anyone violates that constitutional protection by entering your home illegally, you can sue them personally for damages.

YOUR FOURTH AMENDMENT RIGHT:

The Constitution protects you from unreasonable searches and seizures. That means no one can enter your home without:

- A valid warrant signed by a judge
- Your freely given consent
- A legitimate emergency

This bill makes that protection real by giving you the power to fight back when someone violates it.

Why this doesn't violate federal law:

The Westfall Act doesn't block state law.

The Westfall Act protects federal employees from lawsuits only when the government itself can be sued instead. But there are huge gaps where neither the employee nor the government can be held accountable. This bill fills those gaps.

For over a century, Americans could sue federal agents under state tort law for rights violations. The Westfall Act changed this only when the federal government accepted responsibility; otherwise, state law remedies still apply.

This isn't creating a new right. We're not making something up. We're restoring your power to hold people accountable when they violate your Fourth Amendment rights, just like you could for most of American history.

No Consent
= You Can Sue!**

Who can be sued:

You can take legal action against any individual who enters your home in violation of your 4th Amendment rights.

What you can win:

Your case. You can recover:

- Actual damages - compensation for harm done to you
- \$1,000 minimum - even if you can't prove financial harm
- Attorney fees - they pay your legal costs
